32% of students achieved an ATAR greater than 90

Beyond the classroom, our 2010 Year 12 students made outstanding contributions in all other aspects of School life, such as sport, the arts, student leadership and community involvement.

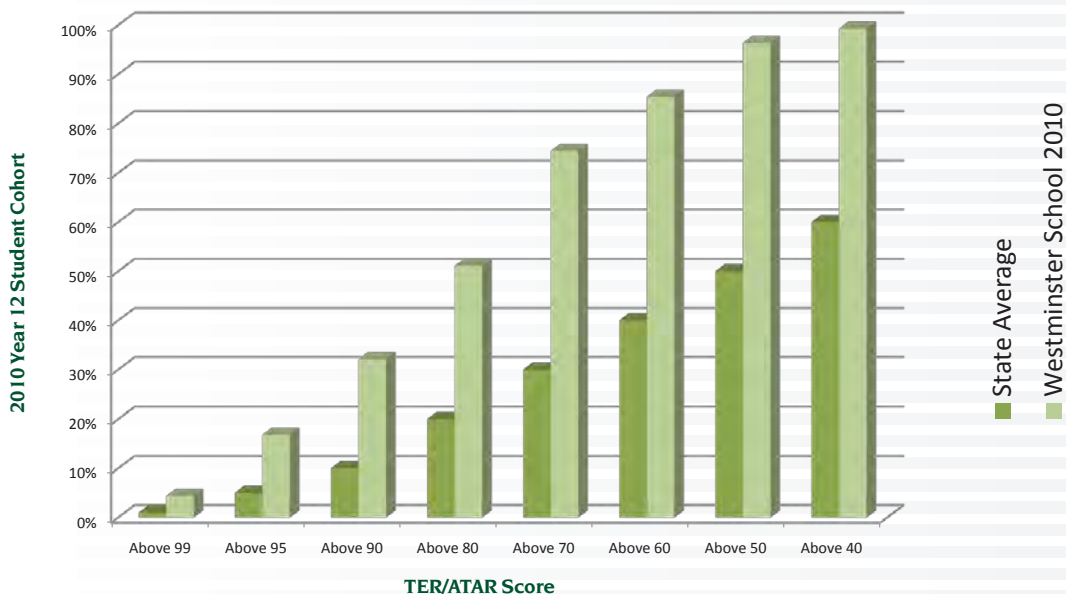
We congratulate all our Year 12 students (Class of 2010) on their personal achievements and thank our staff for their outstanding commitment to our students, both inside and outside the classroom.

SACE AND TER/ATAR 2010

- The percentage of students eligible to receive the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) was 97.9%, slightly above the three year (2008 to 2010) average of 97.6%.
- The average School Achievement Score was 15.3/20, which is slightly above the three year (2008 to 2010) average of 15.0/20.
- The mean Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER), now Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR), was 79.15, slightly above the three year (2008 to 2010) average TER of 78.38.
- The median Tertiary Entrance Rank, now Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR), was 81.45, comparable to the previous two recorded medians of 81.65 in 2009 and 80.0 in 2008.
- A total of 17% of our students gained a TER/ATAR above 95, slightly higher than the three year average (2008 to 2010) of 15%; a total of 51% gained a TER/ATAR above 80, slightly lower than the three year average (2008 to 2010) of 53%; six students achieved a TER/ATAR greater than 99.
- 76.4% of all grades obtained were an A or B, which is higher than the three year average (2008 to 2010) of 73.9%.
