Year 12 2009 Results

Westminster School Year 12 students continued the strong performance that we have seen over the past years with results well above the State averages.

- The percentage of students eligible to receive SACE who did so was 99.3%, which is close to our target of 100%.
- The median Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER) was 81.65. This is slightly better than the previous two recorded medians of 80.0 in 2008 and 78.0 in 2007.
- A total of 56% of our students, representing 53.1% of male and 58.2% of female students, gained a TER over 80, an increase compared to the previous three year average of 51%.
- 72.4% of all grades obtained were A or B, which is slightly lower than the average of 73.3% for the previous three years.

We congratulate all our Year 12 students (Class of 2009) on their personal achievements and thank our staff for their outstanding commitment to our students, both inside and outside the classroom.
