All Year 11 students need a work experience placement in Term 3 – can you help?



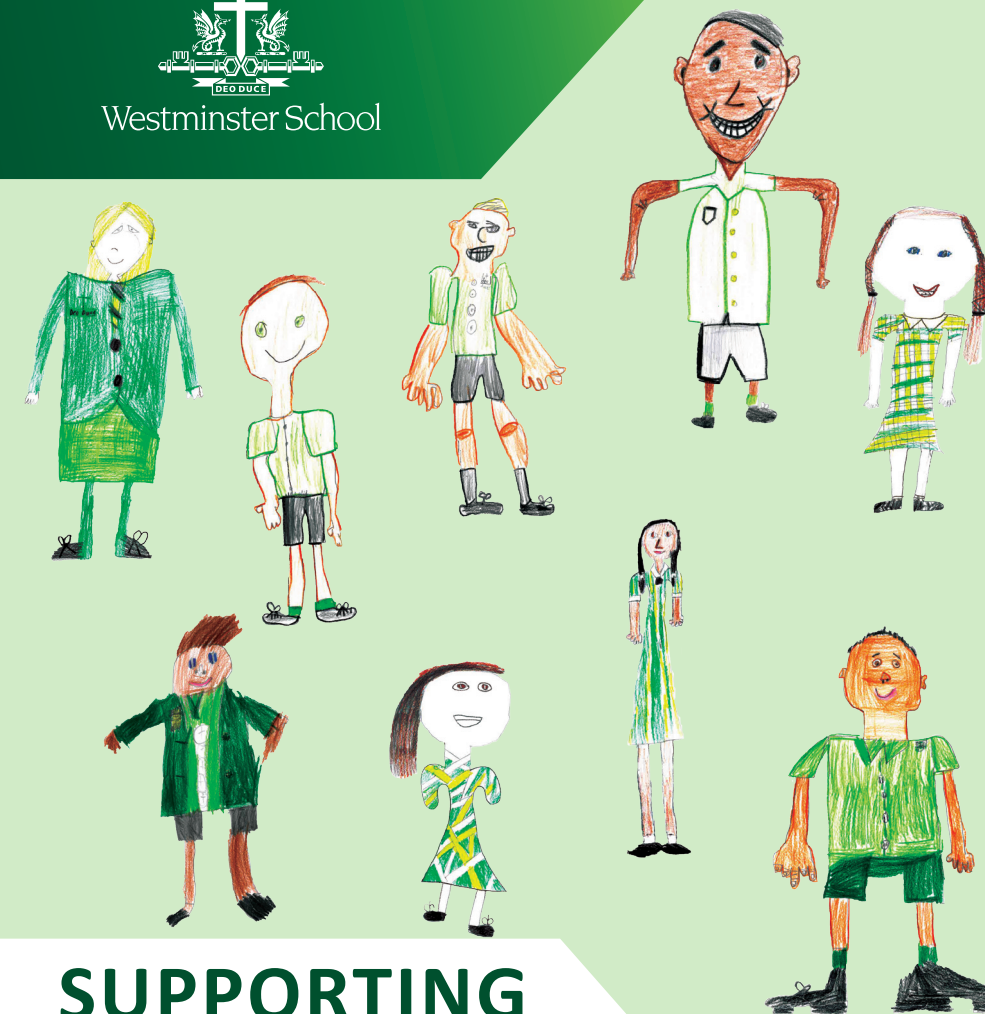
